PROGRAM FOR UNIVERSITY STUDENTS

Erasmus+ is a program for university staff and students.

The general aim of the programme is to support international cooperation among universities and employers in EU Member States and enabling students to go abroad for part of their studies and traineeship as well as promoting the mobility of academic staff.

Students interested in studying abroad within Erasmus+ programme, should get familiar with the **Online Learning Agreement** platform - a simple way to manage the Learning Agreement, which is a central document to ensure the recognition of ECTS earned abroad.

The programme offers mobility opportunities for students in any study field and cycle:

- **short cycle,**
- **Bachelor studies,**
- **Master studies,**
- **Doctoral studies.**

Students can either **study abroad at a partner university** or **carry out traineeship in an enterprise**, a research institute, a laboratory, an organisation or any other relevant workplace abroad.

Students may also have a chance to develop new skills by simultaneously pursuing studies and traineeship abroad.

Students participating in the Erasmus+ programme will receive a MONTHLY GRANT.

The amount of the grant depends on the destination country.

University offers **the ERASMUS+ scholarship for students**, who finished at least 1 year of studies at WSEI University or WSEI graduates, who are interested in experiencing the mobility exchange in any other country of the European Union.

Students participating in the Erasmus+ programme can enroll in free of charge language courses on the **OLS platform** to improve their knowledge of the language in which they will work, study or volunteer abroad.

Students can apply for:

- **STUDIES**
a semester or a year at a host university abroad
- **TRAINEESHIP**
from 2 months up to 12 months during the study programme



BENEFITS OF THE STUDENTS' EXCHANGES

- **Learning or improving foreign language**
 - Getting to **know other cultures** and countries
 - **Building business contacts** and networks
 - **Increasing employment opportunities** in the home country or abroad
 - **Development of skills** such as: adaptation to new conditions, problem solving, creativity
 - Experiencing a **different style of teaching or work**
 - **Meeting new people** and exploring new places
- Getting exposed to **different views, knowledge, teaching and research methods**
 - Gaining **experience in work practices** related to study field
 - Being **more independent**
 - Being **more tolerant** and **open to challenges** and new experiences

During the previous Erasmus+ perspective OVER 120 WSEI UNIVERSITY STUDENTS have participated in Erasmus+ exchange programme.
