## **ERASMUS+**

# RULES ON THE ALLOCATION OF FUNDS AND THE FINANCING OF STAFF MOBILITY OF WSEI UNIVERSITY

### IN THE ACADEMIC YEAR 2025/2026

The detailed rules on the allocation of funds and the financing of staff mobility of WSEI University under the Erasmus+ programme are set out in Annex VI to the agreement concluded between WSEI University and the National Agency for the Erasmus+ Programme.

- 1. A staff member qualified for an Erasmus+ mobility in the academic year 2025/2026 shall receive a grant to cover part of the mobility costs.
- 2. A written financial agreement shall be signed with each staff member selected for the Erasmus+ mobility, specifying the amount of the grant and the form of the payment.
- 3. The funds received to subsidize the staff mobility shall be divided among the eligible staff members in accordance with the following rules:
  - (a) the grant rates paid for mobility to the same countries/cities for the staff of all university faculties/units shall be the same;
  - (b) the duration of the stay at the host university/institution on which the settlement of the grant is based shall be determined with one day accuracy;
  - (C) the grant shall be paid subject to the availability of funds in the project account.
- 4. In accordance with the guidelines of the European Commission set out in the Erasmus+ Programme Guide, the Polish National Agency, in agreement with the Ministry of Education, has established that the staff shall receive EU funding as a contribution to travel and subsistence costs incurred during their stay abroad in accordance with the following tables
